



PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Kings County Association of Governments (KCAG) is updating its Regional Active Transportation Plan (RATP) to increase walking and biking and improve mobility options and the safety of all residents. This 2025 RATP is an update from the 2019 RATP and will leverage recently adopted local agency bicycle plans, pedestrian plans, and Safe Routes to School plans. The 2025 RATP will encompass urbanized areas, such as Downtowns, as well as rural areas between cities and designated community areas.

KEY OUTCOMES

The 2025 RATP will identify areas for improvement to the transportation network to access key destinations such as schools, workplaces, homes, shopping centers, medical and healthcare services, and civic uses. Through public engagement and agency collaboration, the 2025 RATP will promote public health and benefits to disadvantaged communities. Key outcomes of the development of the 2025 RATP will include the following:

- Position the region for successful grant funding pursuits.
- Guide the region with a Complete Streets policy for future development.
- Prioritized transportation improvements based on specific needs and feasible solutions that can be implemented to improve mobility and safety for all users.

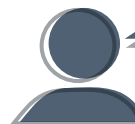
