**FFY 2024 FTA SECTION 5311 PROGRAM OF PROJECTS**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Kings County Association of Governments (KCAG) Transportation Policy Committee will hold a public hearing to consider adopting a "Program of Projects" that shows how the apportionment of FFY 2024 Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5311 apportionment funds will be distributed in Kings County.

FTA Section 5311 funds are available for administrative, capital, and operating expenses incurred by public and private non-profit transportation providers in Kings County.

KCAG has received applications for the following projects:

1. Kings County Area Public Transit Agency:  
KART Operating Assistance \$412,387
2. City of Corcoran:  
Corcoran Dial-A-Ride Operating Assistance \$125,065

Each applicant's request must conform to the policies of the "2022 Kings County Regional Transportation Plan" (RTP) and meet "project programming criteria" adopted for the FTA Section 5311 program.

The hearing will be held on Wednesday, May 22, 2024 at 3:00 p.m. at the City of Hanford, City Council Chambers located in the Civic Auditorium located at 400 N. Douty Street, Hanford. Members of the public who wish to participate in this meeting can do so in one of the following three ways: (1) by attending the meeting in person, (2) by submitting written comments on any matter within the KCAG Commission's subject matter jurisdiction, regardless of whether it is on the agenda for KCAG Commission consideration or action and those written comments will be entered into the administrative record of the meeting, or (3) via Zoom.
