NAS Lemoore Planning Study Group To Hold First Meeting

Lemoore, California, October 11, 2010 - The first meeting of the Naval Air Station (NAS) Lemoore Joint Land Use Study (JLUS) Technical Working Group (TWG) will be held this Friday, October 15th at 10:00 a.m. The meeting will be held at the Kings County Office of Education- Lemoore Service Center in room 306 located at 876 East "D" Street across from the Vineyard Inn Restaurant. The JLUS is an ongoing community land use planning effort between NAS Lemoore and surrounding communities to promote compatible growth while protecting the health, safety, and welfare of the public and address encroachment to NAS Lemoore. The JLUS effort started this past summer and is expected to conclude in the spring of 2011.

The TWG includes representatives from Fresno County, Kings County, City of Lemoore, property owners, education departments, environmental groups, agricultural/water interests, state agencies, airports/airport land use commissions, and businesses. The TWG will review JLUS products prepared to date at the meeting and provide objective information to the NAS Lemoore JLUS Policy Committee. Meetings will be run by a facilitator and no official actions will be taken. Meetings are open to any interested persons.

To date, the JLUS consultants have identified a list of preliminary issues related to compatible development and protecting the community's health, safety, and welfare and will be sharing this information with the TWG on October 15th.
